Wireless Authentication

1.1 SSID in academic buildings : AITguest (for AIT guests only), AITsec, and eduroam provide access as outlined in the table below.

	AITguest	AITSEC	EDUROAM
Wi-Fi Login and Connection Methods	Web based, login every time when connecting	Wifi setting, login once only during setup, auto connect afterwards	Wifi setting, login once only during setup, auto connect afterwards
Campus roaming	No	Yes	Yes
Roaming with other universities	No	No	Yes
Guest account	Allowed	Not allowed	Not allowed

Recommendation: We strongly advise you not to use the SSID "AITguest" which is intended for AIT's guests only. It will automatically disconnect users if the session is idle exceeding the time period specified, thus you may need to repeatedly reconnect again.

Characters accepted in password: Alphabets (A-Z, a-z), digits (0-9) , Password must be at least 8 characters long, following special characters: @ \$ ^ () - _ = ! ' " ~ ` . / \ ; : < > ?

1.4 For Users Who Have Changed Their Password:

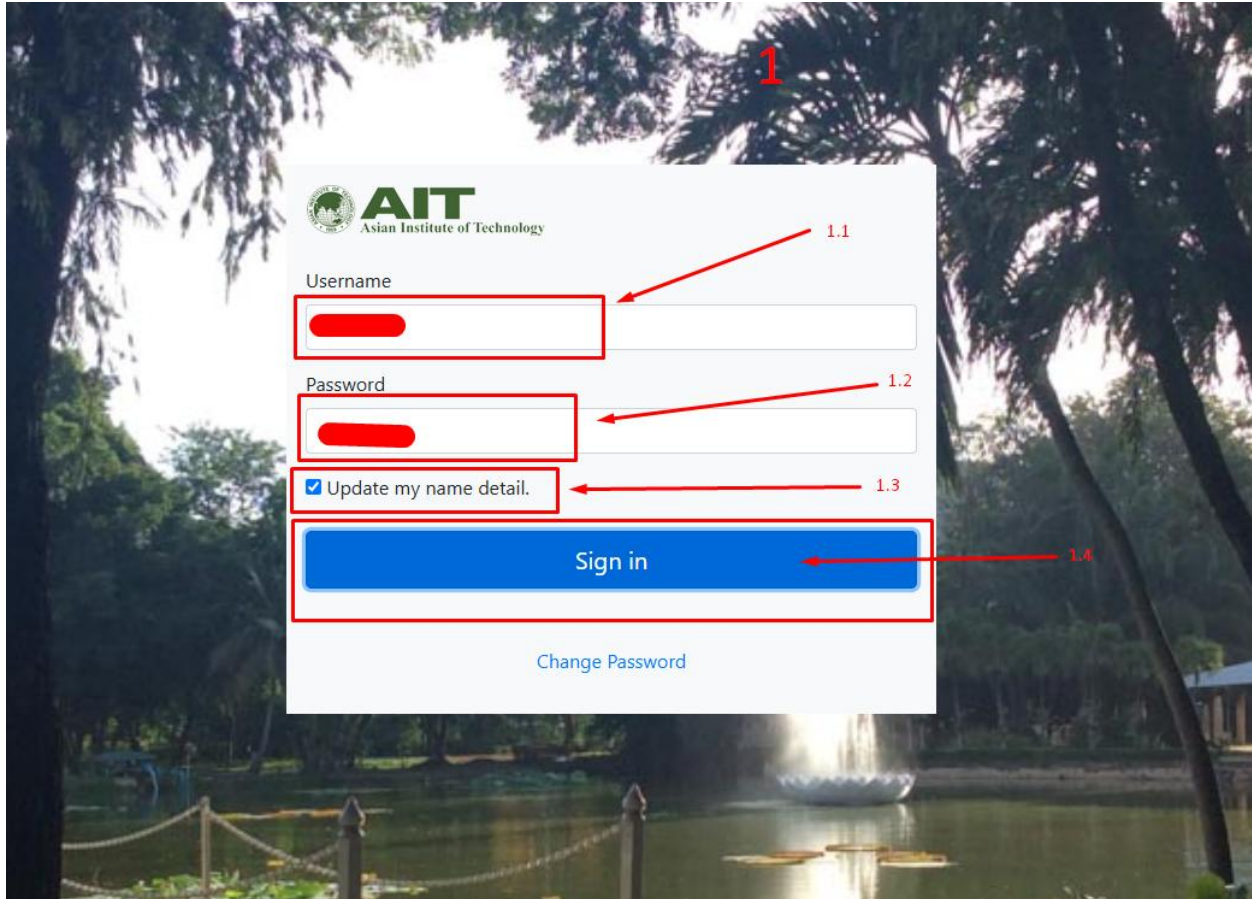
